Dear Parents:

I trust that you were able to attend our Parent/Teacher conferences this week. They are a valuable part of your child's education as you have the opportunity to connect with teachers and find out where your child's strengths and challenges are. With another 6 weeks before the first term reporting period this gives time to put supports in place to ensure their success.

A concern that I hear frequently from the parent community is the high number of COVID notifications that are generated from our school. I feel I need to clarify that although we have had several notices, none of our cases are transmissions in school. That means that all of the cases have come from the community and not from the classrooms. As a staff we are insisting that our students wash their hands when they come into the building, before they go out and before and after eating. This along with keeping children home when they are sick is so important. A reminder that recently the mask mandate has changed to include all grades k-12 students. Please send a mask with your child. We do have some extras in classrooms and at the office, but we do not have enough for every child on a regular basis.

Reminders for Parents

As Fall brings rain and cooler temperatures please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing for outdoors. A good rain coat and rubber boots are so important in keeping your children warm and dry while outdoors. Fresh air is important for physical and emotional wellbeing so going outside for breaks and activities are part of our school day.

This year we will be holding individual grade level assemblies to honour Remembrance Day. This will take place throughout the day on Wednesday, November 10. If possible please have your child wear white, black or red on this day.

Our parking lot is extremely busy especially before and after school. I have noticed many parents walking through the lot and not using our crosswalks. Please always use a crosswalk and hold your child's hand for safety. Thank you.

Fraser Health COVID-19 School Update – Immunization for 12-17 year olds

Health Canada has approved the use of the Pfizer vaccine for youth aged 12 to 17. British Columbia is expanding the COVID-19 Immunization Plan to include this age group.

Youth are excited to protect themselves and their families.

Children aged 12 to 17 can register to get vaccinated now by going to www.gov.bc.ca/getvaccinated, calling 1-833-838-2323 or in person at any Service B.C. centre. Once child(ren) are registered in the provincial system they will be contacted at a later date via the method they indicated (either email or text) to book their vaccine appointment.

Household and group vaccination options are also available to make it easy for households to be immunized at the same time. Multiple young people in a household can attend one booked appointment and be vaccinated together. Young people accompanying adults to the adult's new vaccine appointment can register on site and do not need to be registered or booked in advance. Just let clinic staff know you have arrived.

Ensure all family members bring identification and ideally, their personal health card if they have one.

In the coming days, schools will receive an information package to be shared with families with key information such as how to prepare for and what to expect during your child's vaccine appointment.
