Thank you for your ongoing generosity towards our Gandidzanwa project in Zimbabwe, Africa. In our partnership with Hear Africa over the last 10 years, our school has provided enough support to build a school with many classroom modules and a library. We are currently working towards the final section of the school; a kindergarten module of 4 classrooms. This will cost \$18,000 and so far our brick project has raised over \$3,000. We need to "purchase" 600 bricks at \$30.00/brick and we will meet our goal. We just reached 94 bricks. Please continue to send in loonies, toonies, quarters or whatever you can contribute so we can reach our goal. There is also a option school cash on line option.

We are excited to share that PowerPlay Young Entrepreneurs is coming to LFES once again! The Grade 5's have been busy expanding their entrepreneurial mindset by preparing their individual projects. Students have built a business around crafting and selling a product at our very own in-house entrepreneur fair. They are excited to interact with customers as they put their business plans into action selling one-of-a-kind, handcrafted products. Product at the fair generally range from \$2 to \$15. Giving back is a key part of connecting LFES with our community. A portion of our profits will be donated to a local charity of choice.
