All of these resources are simultaneous access meaning everyone can access them at the same time.

There are three different reading levels on SORA:

- Juvenile and Young Adult: Grades 6-8
- Juvenile, Young Adult and Adult: Grades 9 and up

Welcome to Active Beyond the Bell

General Information

We believe in building healthy individuals and communities to be active and healthy for life. Whether we are playing in the gym, taking advantage of the outdoors, or using a multi-purpose space for games and activities, our staff will ensure your child(ren) are active and healthy each day.

We would like to share a few things with you that will help us make your child's experience fun and memorable:

- The program runs for two hours after dismissal in the gymnasium of your school and ends two hours from the final bell.
- If your child attends Alex Hope Elementary or James Kennedy Elementary, we will provide a supervised walk to Walnut Grove Community Centre.
- Children in grades 2 and up will meet at the gymnasium after the final bell.
- Children in kindergarten and grade 1 will wait at their classrooms and will be picked by an Active Beyond the Bell instructor.

Active Beyond the Bell ends 2 hours from final bell. Parents who arrive late will be charged a late fee. Late fees are processed daily.

Payment Options

- 1. Payment in full at time of registration.
 - Pay by cash, cheque, credit card, or debit.
- 2. Monthly scheduled payments.
 - Monthly payments are due on the first day of each month for registrations within that month. Scheduled payments MUST be done over the phone or in-person. This option is not available with online registration.

Winter/Spring Registration Information

The winter/spring session runs January to June. Registration opens September 13 and 14 at 12:00pm.

Participants registered consistently from September to December with monthly registrations will receive priority registration and will be contacted by phone prior to September 13 to secure their spot for winter/spring sessions.


