I am very pleased to tell you that we are adding another division to our school in September. We will be taking in an extra class of kindergarten students for a total of 5 (current we have 4 kindergarten classes). As class size limits are smaller in kindergarten as they are in grades 1-3, we should be able to have these 5 classes become 4 grade 1 classes the following year. This will restore our school to its previous capacity of 22 divisions.

- Proof of birth date for child (Birth Certificate)
- Proof of citizenship or immigration status for child and parents (Birth Certificate, PR card, immigration or refugee papers, Canadian citizenship card or passport)
- Proof of residence (mortgage papers, property tax notice, BC Driver's License, BC Services Card (with photo), subject free purchase agreement, utility bill)
- Current vaccination records
