Sports Day is just over a week away. I hope that many of you will be able to attend and cheer on your child(ren) and their team. Here's the format for the day (please note that these times are all approximate):

- 8:40-9:00 am** Students arrive in their classrooms and attendance is taken. Announcement will be made for classes to go outside for the team echo cheers.
- 9:00-10:15 am** Stations
- 10:15-10:30 am** Students go inside for recess and snack time (provided by our PAC)
- 10:30-11:45 am** Stations
- 11:45-11:54 am** Students clean up and head inside for lunch
- 12:09-12:35 pm** Lunch bell rings. **All students are provided with lunch from our PAC** (hot dog, chips, bottled water). Students are allowed to go outside for lunch and may buy food from the concession stand at this time.
- 12:35-1:00 pm** Lunch ends. Students head inside for afternoon attendance and short classroom time.
- 1:00-2:00 pm** Announcement made for classes to head outside for the cheer competitions followed by pre-schooler and parent races. This is followed by our tug-of-war competition.
- 2:00-2:40 pm** Students return to classes. Announcement will be made for the point total. At this point parents may go to the classes and pick up children if they wish. **Please do not pick up your child from the playground area as we need to ensure that all of the children are safe and accounted for.** When they return to their classes teachers can release them into your care.

As a safety consideration, please remember to keep your pets at home for the day.
